



## **OCEANA SITE: MIDWAY MANOR FAMILY HOUSING**

Midway Manor community consists of **290 enlisted** units located in the civilian community of Virginia Beach eight miles from NAS Oceana. The neighborhood is located at Princess Anne Road and Windsor Oaks Boulevard.

These units consist of single level and two story brick and vinyl-sided homes with garages. Neighborhood consists of 153 three-bedroom units (1,273 Sq. Ft.), 125 four-bedroom units (1,429 Sq. Ft.) and 12 five-bedroom units (1,606 Sq. Ft.). Forty-seven of the units are handicapped accessible. These homes were constructed in 2001 and 2002 on 97 acres.

Midway Manor is named to commemorate the World War II Battle of Midway Island, a battle that highlighted the importance of naval air power and effectively turned the tide of the war in the Pacific in favor of the Allied Forces. The streets throughout the neighborhood are named for the ships and aircraft that participated in the battle.
