



NORFOLK SITE: CASTLE ACRES FAMILY HOUSING

Neighborhood information: There are 192 Enlisted (E1-E9) single level and 2 story multi-family units, consisting of 45 two bedrooms (800 Sq. Ft.) and 147 three bedrooms (1180-1200 Sq. Ft.). The homes were constructed in 1950 and renovated in 1998. All two-bedroom units are single level. Seventeen units are designated handicap accessible. The Castle Acres neighborhood is one of 3 housing areas located in Norfolk Crossing. The streets throughout Norfolk Crossing are named after communities of Norfolk County, England.

Directions to housing area from Norfolk Site Office: Coming out of parking lot, make right onto Baker Street to traffic light. At traffic light turn right onto Hampton Blvd. At 2nd traffic light make a left onto Terminal Blvd. At 2nd traffic light make a left onto Diven Street. Castle Acres housing is in the Norfolk Crossing community and is straight ahead. The housing is approximately 2.5 miles from Naval Station Norfolk.
